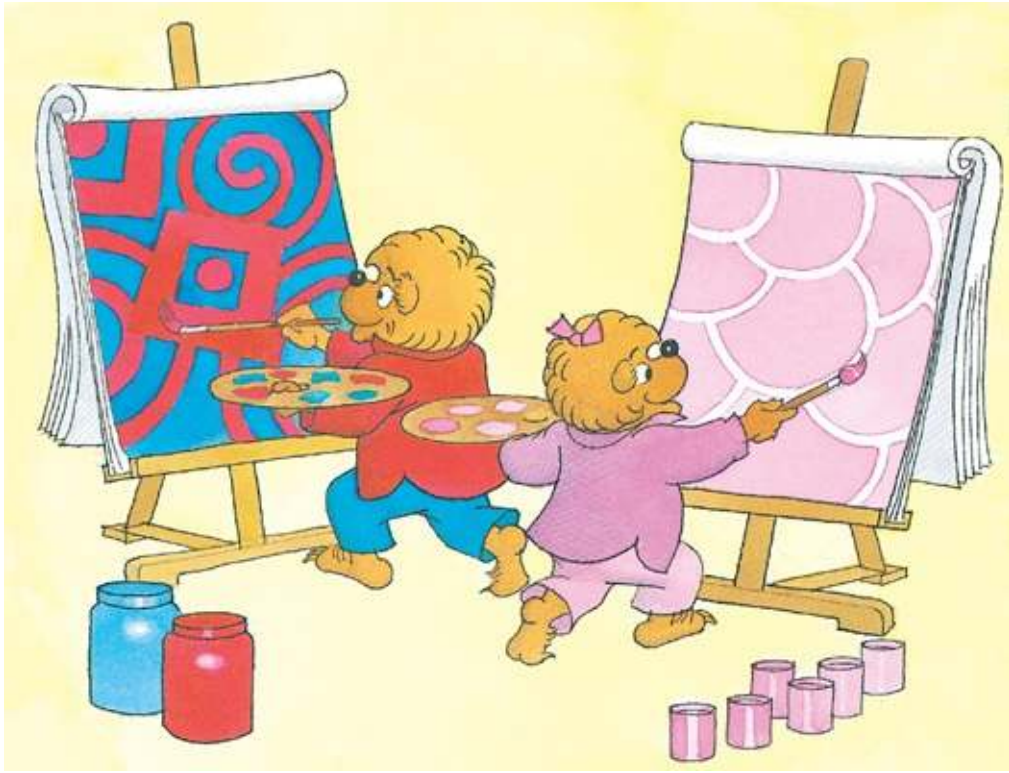
Brother and Sister Bear agreed about the important things in life. They agreed that Christmas and Halloween were the two best holidays.

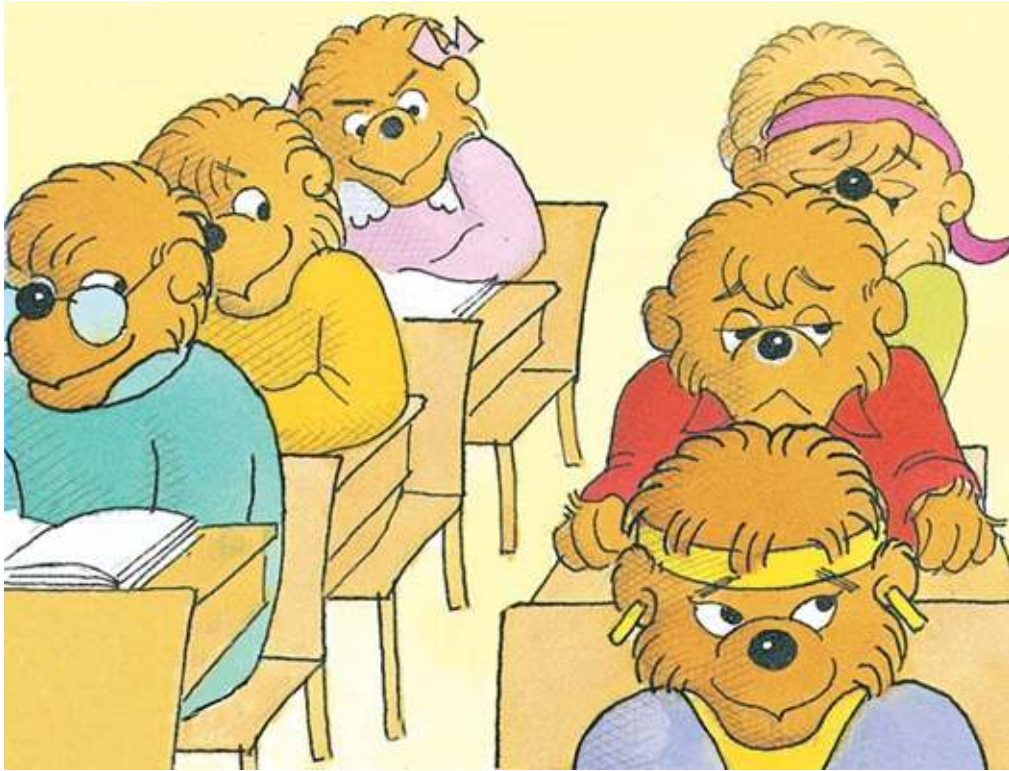
